- -Brad reviewed NWICS fig 10-1 (attached), red dots indicate areas of water collection. Most red dots have street or lot flooding but no major property damage predicted.

Reg's concern: Will situations where lots are flooded be flagged to the owners as part of the development process or as part of the new Lot Grading Bylaw?
