  - Block captains. Might be difficult because everyone is still dealing with the flood. Let them come to us when they're ready
  - Setting up a booth at the fall fair (September 28<sup>th</sup>), giving out coffee cards to engage community members
    - Button machine to engage the kids. Create your own buttons and a prize for the best entry. Winning button could be the task force logo. September 28<sup>th</sup> 11 a.m. - 3 p.m.
